



Accredited Courses



AoME offers a Course Accreditation Scheme for courses aimed at training those involved in the education and training of practitioners and students of medicine, dentistry and veterinary science.

Accreditation provides an independent validation of the quality of academic medical education courses judged against the Academy's Professional Standards. An accredited course can claim to be 'Accredited by the Academy of Medical Educators' and use the Academy's logo on course materials.

Those who successfully complete AoME accredited courses are able to take advantage of a shortened application process; they do not have to provide a Statement of CPD in medical education or a peer review of their teaching. Instead they will be required only to provide a reflective statement on professional values, confirmation that they have successfully completed the accredited course, and to sign a declaration that they support the aims and values of the Academy.

Membership of the Academy allows the use of the post-nominal letters MAcadMEd, and signifies that an individual meets the Academy's Professional Standards for Medical Educators.

Those applying for membership via the accreditation (streamlined) route must have completed the accredited course within the previous two years. The course must have been accredited by the Academy of Medical Educators at the date of completion.
